Chicken Corn Bread Casserole

From: Taste Of Home

Prep: 40 minutes Cook: 3 hours Yield: 6 Servings

Ingredients:

- 5 c. cubed corn bread
- ¼ c. butter, cubed
- 1 large onion(2 cups)
- 4 celery ribs, chopped (2 cups)
- 3 c. shredded chicken
- 1 can Condensed Cream Of Chicken
- 1 can Condensed Cream of Mushroom
- 1/2 c. Chicken Broth
- 1 tsp. Poultry Seasoning
- ½ tsp. Salt
- ½ tsp. Rubbed Sage
- ¼ tsp Pepper

Directions:

Place bread cubes on 15x10x1in.baking pan Bake at 350° for 20-25 min. until toasted. Cool. In skillet, heat butter over med-high heat. Add onion and celery; cook & stir 6-8 minutes until tender. Transfer to a greased crock pot. Stir in corn bread, chicken, soups, broth, and seasoning. Cook on low 3-4 hours or until heated.
