In September, I had the opportunity to attend training at this year's KS NAHRO conference in Manhattan KS. The training was titled: Public Housing Eligibility, Income and Rent Calculations. It was an excellent training and I learned a lot.

I always try to take what I learn in trainings to implement change in order to improve housing authority management/procedures. During this training, I discovered items that our housing authority can improve on beginning with our ACOP. ACOP is short for "Admission and Continued Occupancy Policy". The ACOP was last revised in 2013. Over the next few months, please watch for letters regarding proposed ACOP policy changes.



Utility Allowance Updates & Rent Increases

The housing authority recently completed a utility analysis for all apartment complexes. The results show the average utility expense (from the previous 12 month period) for persons or families living in 1, 2, and 3 bedroom units. The results are reviewed annually by the Housing Authority Board of Directors. If there is a substantial increase or decrease in the amount tenants pay for utilities, the housing authority must adjust the utility allowance accordingly. Below is a breakdown of all changes that will take place. *The effective date for ALL changes will be January 1, 2016.* Tenants affected will receive written notification of these changes and will need to sign an interim recertification with the office.

This year, Cottonwood Acres will also increase the Basic Rent Amount which helps the housing authority keep up with the ever increasing operating expenses. The rent increase will ONLY affect tenants paying flat rent & will not affect tenants paying rent based on their income.

Bedbug Policy

Tenants were notified in July about a proposed bedbug policy for the Halstead Housing Authority. Whenever the housing authority adopts new policies or updates existing policies, we must allow time and opportunity for tenants to provide feedback. After 60 days, the housing authority received no response from tenants regarding the proposed policy. The board of directors will vote on the policy at the September 2016 Regular Board Meeting. If approved, tenants will receive a copy of the policy and will be required to sign and submit the signed policy to the office. Signed policies will be placed in each tenant's file.

The housing authority hopes to keep bedbugs out of our apartments. Tenants can help us by taking the following precautions: Notify the office immediately if bedbugs are found. Avoid when possible purchasing used sofa's, couches, recliners, mattresses, etc. from unknown sources (garage sale furniture may be infested). If bedbugs are found, full cooperation with the housing authority is essential to eliminate them permanently.

Ingredients

- 1/2 c. Butter
