Safety & Security

I am sad to report that in the past couple months we have had a few unsettling experiences involving each of our projects. Cottonwood & Meadowlark had items stolen from the community building & laundry rooms as well as multiple reports of tenants having unacceptable conduct towards one another while in the laundry rooms. Sunflower also had issues with an unidentified person walking around the apartments at night. All incidents have been reported to the Halstead Police Dept. & Chief Steve Lewis was invited to the December Tenant/Staff Meeting to speak to tenants about security issues. The police would like tenants to call 911 for all possible trespassers or suspicious activities observed. You may also report incidents to the office (or after hours use Nikki's cell number) but please call 911 first.

Due to these unfortunate events, the community room locks were changed & the room will now be available by reservation only. We will be placing security cameras in the laundry rooms & by mailboxes at Cottonwood & Meadowlark to monitor activity. We are also placing cameras on buildings at various locations around Sunflower to monitor activity there as well.

Unacceptable behaviors will no longer be tolerated because all tenants have the right to a safe & secure environment. Those who choose to violate the safety & security of others will be held accountable.

A. RSVP stands for Retired & Senior Volunteer Program. It has been around for over 40 years. The program gives seniors the opportunity to use their valuable skills to give back to the community. Peppernuts

Ingredients:

- 1/2 lb Butter
- 1 ½ c. Sugar (cream with butter)
- 2 T Syrup
- 2 Eggs (beaten)
- 3 ¾ c. Flour
- 2 tsp Soda

1 tsp ea.: Cinnamon, Cloves, Ginger, & Anise Cream butter & sugar. Mix syrup & eggs, add to butter & sugar. Mix in remaining ingredients. Refrigerate overnight. Roll into ropes 1/3" wide. Cut & bake 8-10 minutes at 375°.



Lemon Bars

Directions:

- 2 Sticks Butter
- 1/2 c. Powdered Sugar
- 2 c. Flour

Mix butter, sugar, & flour together. Press in 9x13" pan. Bake 350° for 15min.

Topping:

- 4 Eggs (beaten)
- 1/2 tsp Salt
- 2 c. Sugar
- 8 T Lemon Juice
- 1 tsp Baking Powder
- 4 T Flour

Mix ingredients together & pour over curst. Bake 325° for 30 min. Cool and sprinkle with powdered sugar.
