PROPOSED PROJECTS FOR SUNFLOWER HEIGHTS



Possible Eagle Scout Project...

The Housing Authority is working with a local Boy Scout to build a covered picnic table similar to the one shown above as part of his Eagle Scout Service Project. If everything works out, this project will be built at Sunflower Heights just south of the basketball slab. We hope to make this the first addition to a much needed playground area.

Utility Allowances

Based on the last annual Utility Analysis our current Utility Allowances are as follows: **Cottonwood Acres = \$47.00 Meadowlark & Sunflower Heights: 1 BR = \$123**

2 BR = \$158

3 BR = \$229

The Housing Authority is in the process of conducting the annual utility analysis project wide. Tenants that are income based received an authorization form to sign. The authorization gives the housing authority permission to contact utility companies for annual billing information for each apartment. Once all the billing information is gathered, we take an average for each apartment size and determine whether that amount increased or decreased by more than10%. If there is any notable increase or decrease, the Utility Allowance will be adjusted accordingly for that bedroom size. Tenants will be given 30 days notification if rent amounts will change.

Tenants paying Flat Rent amounts will not be affected by any changes to utility allowances. If you have any questions contact the office.

Safety & Security Grant...

In an effort to improve the safety & security at Sunflower Heights, the Housing Authority recently applied for an Emergency Safety & Security Grant through the HUD Capital Fund Program. This funding if awarded will go towards the installation of external security cameras. The cameras will be mounted by sidewalks & parking lots.

Housekeeping Inspections for Meadowlark & Sunflower Heights are scheduled for July 30 & 31. Daniel will accompany Nikki to change HVAC Filters. Please make sure apartments are clean & sanitary. We will be focusing primarily on sanitary conditions; however tenants will be notified if hazards or problems are found.
